Valuation start-up BizEquity set to launch in the UK

A US start-up which specialises in valuing businesses for entrepreneurs looking to sell up is launching in the UK this week.

BizEquity will launch at the tech conference Finovate in London this week.

Traditional valuers charge around £5,000 and take four to six weeks to provide a figure, claims the company. It suggests that business owners can receive a valuation in a tenth of the time, at a tenth of that cost, by using its "cloud-based platform".

The company is backed by Sir Victor Blank, Baron Davies of Abersoch, Sir John Peace and Ben Goldsmith.
